What is an Ocean Guardian School?

An Ocean Guardian School makes a commitment to the protection and conservation of its local watersheds, the world's ocean, and special ocean areas, like national marine sanctuaries. The school makes this commitment by proposing and then implementing a school- or community-based conservation project.

Applications are currently being accepted for participation in the 2024 - 2025 NOAA Ocean Guardian School Program.

Who is eligible to participate in the Ocean Guardian School Program?

PreK - 12 schools in Hawai'i are eligible for participation *with* funding: Grant amounts range from \$1,000 - \$4,000 per school depending on the program region and funding year.
