"Share the Shore" is a call to appreciate wildlife from a distance—for their protection and our safety! When we share the shore and sea with whales, dolphins, sea turtles, monk seals, and corals, we prevent disturbing them from all of the important behaviors and functions that allow them to survive and thrive.

Art must:

- Be the original work of K–12 students.
- Feature protected marine species in the Pacific Islands region (whales, dolphins, turtles, Hawaiian monk seals, and/or corals).
 - Be in the form of a painting, drawing, sculpture, or digital illustration.
 - Not show people in close proximity to wildlife.
